Programmed with love by Salvador Grey and hosted by synth preset gurus [Ultimate Patches](#), this software allows you to edit your JN-80s parameters (even ones hidden in menus) in realtime, as well as acting as a robust patch librarian.

You agree not to redistribute, reverse engineer, or modify the software in any way and will not use it for ai training.

How to use the JN-80 Editor / Librarian

First, unzip the .zip file contents to your desktop or other preferred location on your PC or Mac. The program you just unzipped to your desktop is portable and does not require installation to run.

Connect your JN-80 to your computer via USB and power on the synth. Open the JN-80 Editor and select your JN-80 and MIDI channel there.

Note: It's recommended to use USB MIDI, however if you're not using USB and using standard MIDI 5-pin DIN cables instead, plug in both MIDI IN and OUT on your JN-80 to MIDI OUT and IN on your computer MIDI interface, and select your generic MIDI device in the “Select Device” box and click OPEN WITHOUT USB.

Begin by populating the patch list in the section titled INTERNAL BANKS. Do so by pressing the Refresh List in the left panel. This will transfer all patches from your JN-80 into the librarian. NOTE. Refreshing and clearing the list is only cached data in this editor and will not affect the unit at all. View the tutorial below for a complete overview.

This tutorial video is for the Pro-800 version of the software, however the JN-80 version is built from the Pro-800 version which is virtually identical in function. Note also that the JN-80 version is a standalone program that does not need to be opened in a web browser.
